History of the Foundation

The APMA Scholarship Foundation was established to meet the educational needs of deserving employees and children of APMA member companies. The Foundation was created to encourage and benefit students within Arizona's petroleum industry. The Foundation was established as a nonprofit Arizona corporation in 2007.

Eligibility

Applicants must be:

- An APMA member, an employee or a child of an APMA member or employee residing in Arizona. The APMA Member must be in good standing for a minimum of one year as of the application deadline. The applicant or the applicant's parent must be employed a minimum of one year as of the application deadline.
- High school seniors or graduates and college students who are enrolled or will be enrolled in a full-time course of study at an accredited public or private two or four year college, university or vocational/technical school.

Awards

A limited number of scholarships will be awarded each June to selected students. If the student meets eligibility requirements (maintenance of a 3.0 cumulative grade point average), the scholarship can be renewed. Awards will be granted without regard to race, color, religion, sex, disability or national origin.
