Hello,

The Arizona Department of Transportation Motor Vehicle Division began issuing Arizona's newly redesigned driver license/identification card on June 16. The upgraded credential has enhanced security features to safeguard personal information and help prevent identity theft. This is combined with a new central issuance process to increase customer safety and security.

Customers will receive a temporary license or ID before leaving an MVD or Authorized Third Party office, and they will receive the permanent credential in the mail within 15 days. The temporary contains a photo and the basic information that appears on the actual credential. It is printed on security paper for added customer protection. The decision to accept the temporary credential as proof of identity exists solely with the organization requesting to see the license or identification card.
